The community of Our Lady of Graces acknowledges the Jaggera and Turribul people, the Traditional Custodians of the land on which our parish stands.

Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

The first sentence of the gospel reading sets the context for the themes of today: 'Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of the bread.' Who is the Jesus that they recognised? And what does this recognition require?

Jesus is the servant of the God of the early ancestors, the long awaited messiah, and the innocent sufferer portrayed in the prophetic tradition. He is the fulfilment of our deepest aspirations. When we gather around the



table for the sacramental meal, we encounter the Risen Lord. There the sacred traditions of our religious heritage are opened for us and we are enabled to recognise him in the traditions and in the breaking of the bread.

In order to encounter the Risen Lord in the breaking of the bread and in the breaking open of the word, we need docile hearts ready to embrace the deepest meaning of our religious heritage. We need hearts that have been purified in the love of God; hearts that have been totally transformed. The commandment of love requires nothing less.

Having recognised the Risen Lord, we, like the people described in the first reading, must live reformed lives. Having recognised the Risen Lord, we, like the people addressed in the second reading, must be obedient to God's commandment of love. Having recognised the Risen Lord, we, like the disciples portrayed in the gospel, must preach the good news of God's forgiveness to all nations. Easter faith assures us that all of this is possible.

Private Prayer in the Church


The church is open during parish office hours for private prayer. Entry into the church is via the office.

Parish Finance Council Update

Your Parish Finance Council has been reviewing several areas to assist with the ongoing impact to COVID-19 restrictions on attendance and support for our Parish. One area is the Planned Giving and payment for various programmes that are administered on a regular basis. With the trend away from physical cash payments, we had a deep review on payment systems for the Parish Staff as well as for the Planned Giving. I am pleased to advise the Parish is introducing two new systems. The first is to allow debit and credit cards donations and payments to be made on our parish website via a system called BPOINT. The second is to assist with giving for those who prefer to donate without a formal plan via a secure app for those with smart phones. A further explanation of the app will be provided in Spread the Word next weekend.

Additionally, we are seeking quotes to air condition the Aquinas Room (the room under the Church) which is used on a regular basis by several of the Parish-based groups.

The ongoing restrictions to attendance numbers has been a key area of focus. It is very pleasing to advise, with the support of the Parish Team, the income shortfall to set costs has decreased. This is due to a positive uplift in recent months, a decrease in some expenses, and some positive inflow of funds for various activities.

The recent storms and heavy rain have tested the roof repairs carried out last year and I am pleased to note these repairs kept the church secure.

Call out for new members: could you please consider your ability to attend a meeting and consider joining your Parish Finance Council as we are seeking new members and would welcome your fresh approach to how we can be good Stewards of the Parish. Please pray on this and speak to Fr Alex or Chris in the Parish Office. Our next meeting is on Monday 14 June at 7.30pm in the Parish Library.


