Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

Pentecost brings the Easter season to a close, celebrating the fullness of the Spirit and the great gathering of nations. The plan of salvation has been brought to its conclusion. The Risen Lord is exalted in his rightful place next to God and has sent his own Spirit to fill the earth with God's power. The world is charged with divine energy; it needs but a spark to ignite it with life and excitement.

If this has all really happened, why does our world look the same? Why is there so much religious and ethnic rivalry? Why do we continue to make distinctions between Jew and Gentile, slave and free, woman and man, distinctions that favour one at the expense of the other? Why is there so little peace, or comfort, or solace? Why do we refuse to forgive or to be reconciled? Is Pentecost merely a feast that we celebrate in red vestments? We are immersed in the vigour of the Spirit of God; all we have to do is open ourselves to it and the reign of God will be born in our midst.

Every five years, to coincide with the Australian National Census, the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference asks for data on Mass




NATIONAL COUNT OF ATTENDANCE

LITURGY SNIPPET: History and Use of Sequences in the Liturgy

The Sequence is generally thought to have begun, as a genre of poetry, around the 9th Century, when Roman chant was flourishing and spreading throughout Europe. As Roman chant was intended primarily as a musical meditation upon the Word of God, so the Sequences at Mass were intended as musical, meditative extensions of the Alleluia verse. In certain places within the western Church, a Sequence was employed for nearly every Sunday and holyday of the year. Historically, the Sequence has been sung at various locations within Alleluia/Gospel Acclamation. The positioning of the Sequence allowed it to act as an extension of the Alleluia verse and as a processional chant for a more solemn procession with the Book of the Gospels.

The 2011 General Instruction of the Roman Missal specifies that the Sequence is now to be sung before the Alleluia. Its placement today preserves a stronger connection between the Alleluia and the Gospel, and transforms the Sequence into a more contemplative meditation on the mystery of the day in preparation for the Gospel. The assembly remains seated, in a posture of meditation, for the Sequence, and stands when the Alleluia is begun. There are now only two days of the calendar when the Sequence is obligatory, with one being Pentecost Sunday. As is the custom of our parish, we sing the Sequence before the Gospel Acclamation today.
