

# Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

The overarching theme of the readings for this Sunday is 'words spoken in truth'. On one level, the laws are the words of the covenant. They are part of the contract that was drawn up between God and the people. They are words of truth, because they are the reliable revelation of God and because they genuinely reflect righteous living. The biblical covenant laws are truly humane. Obedience to the words of the covenant leads to life and blessings, while disobedience results in the opposite.

Our religious customs always carry some profound religious meaning, but we may not know or care



When the word of God has taken root in us, everything becomes a religious practice. This word can come to us through the teachings of our faith, through the example of good people around us, through the wonder and mystery of creation. When it does take hold of us, our inner eye is opened, our hearts are softened, and we turn instinctively to God like a flower turns to the sun. When we are brought to birth in this way, covenant law becomes sacred, religious practices are cherished, and we are filled with the power that saves.



Today, Sunday 29 August, we celebrate Social Justice Sunday.

This year, the Australian Bishops' Social Justice Statement is titled:

Cry of the Earth, Cry of the Poor.

The statement invites us to join in responding to Pope Francis' invitation to take a seven-year journey towards total ecological sustainability guided by seven Laudato Si' Goals. The Statement provides theological foundations to ground and inspire our efforts to care for creation while responding to the needs of the disadvantaged and excluded.

#### Parish Financial Half Year Review: January - June 2021

As you can see, we are basically breaking even when comparing our income to expenses for the first six months of 2021. This has come from the Parish being as diligent as possible with expenses.

By way of comparison, our total income for the same January - June period in 2019 was \$143K and for 2021 it was \$125K. Therefore, we have seen a drop in approximately 18K over the two years. We understand that COVID has played a large part of this, especially with a drop in Mass attendance.

However, thank you to everyone who gives via either direct debit, credit card, the Parish Giving app, envelopes, or cash on the plate at Mass. We encourage anyone who is currently giving via envelopes or cash on the plate to consider giving via direct debit instead. Chris in the parish office can assist you with this.

The Parish Finance Council would like to acknowledge the outstanding support and stewardship of Patrick Andersen, whom after 9 years with the Finance Council has taken well earned leave. The Parish Finance Council would like you to pray and consider bringing your skills to the Council to help steer your Parish into the future. We meet around 6 times per year. 


