## Reflection by Nick Brodie

Today's Gospel reveals a fearfulness in the disciples' response to Jesus. Afraid of asking too many questions, they almost seem to prefer being ignorant rather than admit the limits of their own understanding. Strangely, this self-imposed ignorance does not prevent them from posturing for position. What a warning for the Church this episode seems to offer!
While this excerpt of Mark's Gospel is often interpreted in terms of the virtue of humility, the other aspect of Jesus' point is easily overlooked. Every Christian is called to be 'last of all and servant of all'. Ours is a faith of humble service.


The scriptures repeatedly make the point that faith is always embedded in creation. A mountain, a road, a town, and a house all frame the action in this episode. Because the Church exists wherever its members go our beliefs and prayers are not restricted to church buildings. We take our faith on roads, into our homes and towns, and even up mountains.
Given this, our faith compels us to have a special care for all of creation. As Jesus clearly intimates, by humbly serving created things we express our love of the Creator who made them all.

Nullarbor priest takes care of 'soul' parishioner From bustling Manila to the quiet Nullarbor Plain, Fr Harold Camonias (pictured right) has found
 that no journey is too long or difficult when God not only sends and accompanies you but even meets you at the destination.
Heading off to say Mass, Fr Camonias packs his car with all the necessities including firewood, water, a sleeping bag, tent and camp stove.
After a long and solitary drive (a 500 -kilometre round trip), Fr Camonias arrives and unlocks the Church and prepares to celebrate Mass ... for one.
Gerry Agnew is the "soul" parishioner in Leigh Creek, a former coal-mining town with a population of around 200. Living on his own, the 60 -something-year-old local arrived from Ireland "many, many, years ago" and remembers a time when it was standing room only at Mass.
Fr Camonias is the parish priest of Flinders Ranges, which includes Quorn, Hawker, Carrieton, Leigh Creek and surrounds, in the Port Pirie Diocese, which occupies 980,000 square kilometres, most of the state of South Australia including spiritual Uluru (Ayers Rock).
He believes the region should be known as the "soul" not the centre of Australia, and says his vocation is inspired by Catholics like Gerry who despite receiving the Eucharist only a few times a year has such strong faith.
He said he believes it's God's will that he spreads the Good News and leads people into personal encounters and relationships with Christ wherever they are, including Leigh Creek.

## Saint Matthew (21 September)

 According to the Gospel, Matthew was working at a collection booth in Capernaum when Christ came to him and said, "Follow me." With this simple call, Matthew became a disciple of Christ.From Matthew we know of the many doings of Christ and the message Christ spread of salvation for all people who come to God through Him. The Gospel account of Matthew tells the same story as that found in the other three Gospels, so scholars are certain of its authenticity. His book is the first of the four Gospels in the New Testament.
Many years following the death of Christ, around 41 and 50 AD, Matthew wrote his gospel account. He wrote the book in Aramaic in the hope that his account would convince his fellow people that Jesus was the Messiah and that His kingdom had been fulfilled in a spiritual way.
Matthew was a tax collector and is therefore the patron saint of bankers.
