Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

Paul teaches us that, united to Christ through faith and in baptism, we are united in his death and resurrection. With Christ we die to sin; with him we rise to a new life. We cannot wait to see proof of our transformation before we change our actions. The proof is in the lives we live in faith. To deny that we have died and been raised is to deny the resurrection of Christ. Paul insists that they cannot be separated. The challenge is to live in and out of this faith.

Both Jeremiah and Jesus introduce us to such a way of living. It is a way of paradox, a way that moves us beyond the self-centred standards of the world. The poor, the



the self-centred standards of the world. The poor, the hungry, those who weep, and those who are persecuted are really the ones who are blessed. The victims of our social and economic systems, those who have been ravaged by war or have been made vulnerable by life itself are the ones who, if they place their trust in God, will be blessed in the end. They may appear

to be the outcasts of this world, but, if they are filled with faith, they will inherit

heaven. The wealth of this world and its pleasures are not the blessings that we

might think they are. They can blind us to the real values of life and prevent us from dying to the world and living resurrected lives in Christ.

Gospel Focus - Treated as the prophets

As part of his sermon, Jesus announces, 'Happy are you when people hate you, drive you out, abuse you, denounce your name as criminal, on account of the Son of Man... This was the way their ancestors treated the prophets.' The prophets of the Old Testament were the chosen spokesmen of God. Their message was often unpopular and they were often threatened and berated for challenging the social order. To be treated in this way is in fact something of an affirmation that one's words and actions are reflecting the message of God. The Word of God is confronting and challenging!

Qld Check-In App

The Queensland Government this week announced changes in relation to the Qld Check-In App.

- At venues where unvaccinated people are permitted to attend, <u>i.e. churches</u>, the parish will no longer need to collect contact information from attendees via the Check In app.
- On special occassions, such as the Easter Triduum, where we know we will go above our currently capacity limit, we may need to have a booking system e.g. Eventbrite.

The couple of exceptions for the parish are wedding ceremonies and private venue hire, which are rare situations and will be communicated with those concerned as and when they occur.

Thank You to all our Marsahls who have each week stepped up ensure everyone has been checked-in and counted for. Their roles will now reduce, for the time being, with the change in contact tracing.


