Gospel Reflection by Greg Sunter

Lent is a time when we are reminded that there is nothing we can do to win our salvation. It is a pure gift from God. Like Jesus in the wilderness, we are to allow God's plan to unfold in and through us. Lent is a time for us to enter actively into the mysteries of the death and resurrection of Jesus, and there to marvel at what God has done for



The temptations of Jesus are the same temptations that we face when we are inclined to think that somehow we

are in control. While the goals of the temptations may be admirable - feed the hungry, bring the world under the control of good, trust in God's power to protect us – we often choose to accomplish them in ways that are less than admirable. We try to perform the extraordinary so that what we do reflects favourably on us. We use brute force in order to achieve control. We put God to the test rather than live peacefully with God's plan as it unfolds within and around us. We seek to become the super-hero, the super-minister, the super-Christian on our own. In his responses to the tempter, we see Jesus constantly deferring to the power of God: It is not by bread alone . . . worship only God . . . do not put God to the test. In a real sense, these temptations are a reminder that the fundamental temptation is to deny our human limitations and refuse to let God be God for us.

Less in Lent

Lent is a season for stripping away excess in order to make space for God. Unlike the Gathering / Entrance hymn, the Sending Forth / Recessional hymn has never actually been part of the Mass. Mass ends with the priest's blessing wherein we are sent forth to live and spread the Gospel. Therefore during the season of Lent, which has been our parish practice the last number of years, we have lessened the music by not having a Sending Forth / Recessional hymn and instead depart in silence.

COVID Update & Changes

Changes came into place for Places of Worship, effective from Friday 4 March 2022, 6pm.

What has changed?

- Masks are no longer required indoors for Places of Worship. Masks are recommended to be worn whenever you cannot socially distance.
- Places of worship no longer have capacity limits.
- You may now sit in any pew, but it is recommended that you socially distance as much as possible.
- Normal collection practices may resume, that is, the collection basket may be passed around.
- The Procession of Gifts may resume.
- The Rite of Reconciliation can be made available as per pre-COVID arrangements.
- All forms of food service can resume. As a matter of caution, it is recommended that the sharing and handling of serving tongs, milk jugs etc. be kept to a minimum.

What has not changed?

- Continue with our COVID cleaning protocols.
- Hand sanitiser will still be made available at the entrance of the church.
- The holy water fonts will still remain empty.
- The Sign of Peace is still limited to saying "Peace be with you" with a nod or bow; no hand-shaking or hand-holding should occur here or at the Our Father.
- The Body of Christ is still administered only in the hand and the chalice only received by the celebrant/s alone.
- Spread the Word will still be handed out at the end of Mass.
