
Spread the Word

Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

As disciples we commit ourselves to values and principles that are not always cherished by others. We can be misunderstood for our beliefs, even ridiculed. Our lives may be a reproach to those who do not share our aspirations. There may be times when we must stand in opposition to others. All of this tends to alienate us. It could even place us at enmity with those whom we love. Yet, if we are genuinely committed, we realise that there is also a price to pay if we are not faithful. It is very difficult to live with ourselves when we



disregard our deepest convictions and ignore the promptings of God that we experience within ourselves. As difficult as a life of faith may be, we know that it is the only way to live in this world.

Faced with the cost of discipleship we are brought to the realisation that, by ourselves, we do not have the necessary resources. We need assistance. Like Jeremiah, we might find that this aid will come from places we may have never expected. The real support and assistance that we get is from Jesus who came to set the world and our hearts on fire. Paul assures us that there is a vast throng cheering us on as we run the race of discipleship. They are not merely spectators; they have already run or are still running their own race. We are not alone in our commitment, in our struggle. There are many witnesses, many examples for us to follow.

Plenary Council Outcomes

What is a Plenary Council? A Plenary Council is the highest formal gathering of the Catholic Church in a nation. The second sitting of the most recent Plenary Council in Australia concluded in July 2022. The purpose of the Plenary Council has been to discuss what God is asking of us in Australia at this present time through a process of discernment, prayer and dialogue.



What came out of it? During the process, members from across Australia voted on and passed 18 proposals. Four particular proposals covered the following topics:

- Care for Creation: Committing all Catholic churches and organisations to adopt specific goals for responding to the climate crisis.
- **Dignity of Women:** Make changes to policies and practices around the involvement of women, ensuring that women are appropriately represented in decision-making and equally remunerated in employment.
- Formation for Mission: Ensure leaders have a strong foundation in their faith so that decision-making in mission and ministry comes from a place of faith in God, through creating a culture of personal and communal prayer and engagement in the sacramental life of the Church.
- **Reconciliation:** For the Catholic Church in Australia to actively work towards reconciliation with First Nations Peoples.

What does it mean and where to from here? The decrees of the Plenary Council need papal approval which we hope to receive in early 2023. This will make the Plenary Council decrees binding for the Catholic Church in Australia, and allow us to move into the implementation phase.

In the meantime the Archdiocese of Brisbane will continue to move ahead in a number of these areas and begin determining how to embed Plenary Council proposals into our organisation at every level – from Catholic schools and parishes to religious institutes Catholic organisations and Agencies.
