## Preparation for Lent

The Church's calendar is broken up into times or seasons which help us as we make our yearly journey in faith. We have seasons of preparation and seasons of celebration. Each of these work together to lead us into a deeper understanding of our relationship with God and with each other. One of the great seasons, which is known in our secular society as well as in the Church, is the season of Lent.
Lent is a time of preparation for the festival of Easter and all that means. Lent of itself has very little meaning but because it draws us into the Feast of Easter and Resurrection. It is very important in our yearly cycle. Lent has around it many customs, practices and traditions. Some of which are helpful, others have just become things that we do because we have always done it that way. This season has its own importance, which should never be under estimated or drawn out unduly because we are people of the resurrection and new life.
Our preparation for the season of Lent, is simply that. Not a drawing out of the Lenten season but rather a time of physical and spiritual preparation. Within the Jewish tradition, leading up to Passover, families will physically clean their houses searching for any Leaven (Bread), so that they can celebrate Passover in ritual cleanliness. As Christians, what is it that we need to remove not so much from our homes, but from our lives so that we can get the most benefit from this time.
Reconciliation (confession) is a good way to spiritually start this time. Thinking about what we might abstain from, not simply meat on Friday, gives us an opportunity to look at what things are not necessary in our lives. We abstain or give up food, drink, or some activities, not simply to give them up, but might be freed from attachment or given time that then may be used to deepen our relationship with God the creator of time and the giver of all good things. Over the next few weeks, not beginning our Lenten disciplines, but thinking how we might use Lent to the best advantage. May we consider what we need to detach from, what time can be given, and what practices we may take on so that when Lent begins, we are ready from Ash Wednesday to draw closer to the Lord.

## LENT

Ash Wednesday, 22 February, marks the beginning of the Lent. Mass times on Ash Wednesday at Our Lady of Graces will be $6.30 \mathrm{am}, 9.00 \mathrm{am} \& 6.00 \mathrm{pm}$ (please note the earlier time for the evening Mass).
Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year (CCL 97, 1251-52)

Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday evenings during Lent at 7.00 pm commencing on 24 February.
Please note there will be no Stations of the Cross on Friday 24 March, due to the Parish Mission.
