

Sunday Mass at Our Lady of Graces Parish

It is essential that you booking each week to attend Sunday Mass at Our Lady of Graces Parish. This is particularly important now as we are reaching capacity at all Sunday Masses based on 1 person per 4m² rule.

- To attend Sunday Mass, please make a booking by going to www.carinacatholicparish.org.au and on the "Mass Bookings" image. clicking **Bookings open on Monday morning and close** on Friday at midday of each week.
- Bookings must have the correct contact details of each person.
- Parishioners who do not have internet access may phone the parish office on 3398 2977 during office hours.
- Booking for Sunday Mass ensures you a seat, as long as you arrive before Mass starts. It also helps to make the process guick and easy for the marshal at the door and also for yourself.
- Please arrive early. This so everyone is seated when Mass starts.
- If you turn up at a Sunday Mass without a booking, there is no guarantee that space will be available. You will be turned away if we are at capacity.

- What is "violence against women"?

Violence against women is any act of gender-based violence that causes or could cause physical, sexual or psychological harm or suffering to women, including threats of harm or coercion, in public or in private life (UN Declaration).


In Australia, violence against women is called many different things, including domestic violence, family violence, intimate partner violence, sexual harassment and sexual assault.

On average, one woman a week is murdered by her current or former partner in this country.

Almost 10 women a day are hospitalised for assault injuries perpetrated by a spouse or domestic partner.
