Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Reflection by Dianne Bergant CSA

We have now come to the end of the liturgical year, the point that marks the transition from one period to another. Today we see that the kingdom of God is inclusive. Its embrace is as comprehensive as is the embrace of God. Criteria for membership are not based on obedience to the commandments or on conformity to ritual obligation, but on the bonds of love and concern.



What we do for others, we do for Christ, because Christ is identified with those in need. We very seldom see the face of the glorified Christ in the faces of the needy; it is more often the face of the disfigured Christ that is turned to us. We see his fear and his shame, his brokenness and sense of loss. As difficult as it may be to look into such eyes, it is precisely the needy with whom Christ is identified.

Having entered into the frailty of human nature, identified himself with the needy, and handed himself over to death, in the end Christ will have conquered all. It is a curious kingdom that he has won, a kingdom of the weak rather than the strong. He has turned the standards of the world upside down. He has shown that it does not take strength to ignore or to exploit the needy, but it does take strength to overcome our own selfishness in order to serve them. The kingdom that Christ hands over to God is a kingdom of love and care.

COVID-19 Update & Changes

Effective from last Tuesday, 17 November 2020, 4pm, changes came into place for Places of Worship.

What has changed under the new guidelines?

- Both indoor rooms and outdoor spaces for Places of Worship can now have a maximum of one person per 2 square metres, regardless of the size of the space. We can, therefore, cater at least 200 in the church.
- Please note that physical distancing is to be observed to the extent possible. This means that people should distance as much as they can while adhering to the current occupancy restriction of one person per 2 square metres. It may be challenging to achieve 1.5 metre physical distancing at full capacity, but people should distance as much as practically possible in these situations. People living in the same household are not required to physically distance from each other.

At Our Lady of Graces, we will continue to use every 2nd pew to keep the distancing between rows. The green dots remain only at the ends of the pews, so you know which pews you can sit in.

• Weddings and Funerals can have up to 200 people in attendance.

What has <u>not</u> changed under the new guidelines?

- · Cleaning protocols remain the same.
- Contact details must be collected for all visitors and Mass attendees and stored securely for at least 56 days
- If food and drink is served, you comply with the Food Services Industry Plan and ensure there is no self-service or buffet style food and that participants are seated.
- All Catholics remain dispensed from their Sunday obligation until further notice.
- The Sign of Peace should be without physical contact.
- The Body of Christ should be administered only in the hand and the chalice should be received by the celebrant alone.
- Collections should be contactless that is, no passing a plate from person to person.

Our Lady of Graces Christmas Masses 2020

Due to the COVID restrictions, there will be a slight alteration to the usual Christmas Mass schedule. This is so we can accommodate the anticipated numbers that usually attends each



Christmas Mass. We won't be able to have the usual large Masses with the congregation spilling outside the church. Bookings will need to be made to attend Christmas Mass and marshalling to take place.

The Christmas Mass timetable for 2020 is currently being finalised and will be published next weekend, together with the booking information. Bookings for the Christmas Masses will open on 1 December.

Private Prayer in the Church

The church is open during parish office hours for private prayer. Entry into the church is via the office. Please be weary, due to COVID restrictions, that the church is not available while there is a funeral.
