#### **Our Response to the Coronavirus**

With a relatively small number of confirmed cases of coronavirus or COVID-19 in Australia, the risk to the general public remains low. However, given the regular assembly of large groups for liturgical celebrations, including our Sunday Masses, the Bishops of Australia have provided us with guidelines to help minimise the spread of the virus.

As from this Sunday, following advice from health authorities both State and National and the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference, the following will be implemented in the Parish of Our Lady of Graces, Carina.

- Individuals should consider their own health, including any potential to infect others with a contagious disease, before attending a public liturgical celebration.
- Holy Water will be temporarily removed from stoups at the doors of the church to reduce the possibility of transmission of the virus. Holy Water will continue to be available for people to take home.
- When exchanging the Sign of Peace, individuals should avoid shaking hands but say "Peace be with you" and offer a smile, wave, nod or bow.
- All Ministers of Holy Communion are to take particular care to wash their hands before and after distributing. Appropriate means will be made available.
- The Parish will cease distributing Holy Communion from the Chalice until further notice. The faithful are reminded that Christ is fully present under either species.
- The coronavirus is easily spread through saliva. In celebrations of the Ordinary Form of the Latin Rite, the Body of Christ will therefore only be administered in the hand for the interim because of the high risk of transmission if people continue to receive on the tongue. Ministers should seek to avoid contact with the communicant's hands.
- Those who are too unwell to attend Sunday Mass whether due to coronavirus or some other condition or are at particular risk of contracting the COVID-19 virus can honour their Sunday obligation by participating in a time of prayer within the home, reading the Scriptures or watching Mass on television.

These measures are introduced to maintain the safety and health of this community. They are not to be seen as a change in our liturgical practice, but rather are introduced for safety reasons. We pray that this medical crises will pass and that those who are affected may experience the healing power of God.

During December, OLOG Parishioners Elisha (Ellie) Hiscock and Joe Corbett spoke at Masses to create awareness, and



garner a little support for their year ahead. Both have committed to a year as members of the National Evangelisation Team (NET). To join NET, one must put "normal life" on hold for a year, and commit to a year of reflecting Christ's love to other young people through a range of activities including prayer, workshops and song.

On 22 February 2020, 45 youngsters were commissioned for ministry at an uplifting Eucharist celebrated at Sacred Heart Church, Rosalie. As you can see from the photo, Ellie & Joe were delighted to have Fr Alex concelebrating at that Mass.

All the NETters Joe has introduced to us reflect a strong, authentic sense of mission as each day unfolds before them anew. I cannot think of a more countercultural way for a millennial to spend a year of life. NETters:

- Leave one day with minimal belongings, but must have a Bible and a wristwatch [interesting times: millennials unfamiliar with the latter];
- Initially disappear for six weeks to commune with 44 like-minded faithful youth from across Australia and the globe, participating in rigorous training which includes full day (tech free!!) retreat, training in conducting workshops, instructions in how to cook and skills test to reverse a van with a trailer attached;
- Are formed into a small group, and fly away fired up for Mission on a regime which includes restricted access to social media and communication, a strict budget, limited creature comforts and community life;

And so Ellie, Joe and four others NETters find themselves in Fitzroy, serving the schools and parishes of the Archdiocese of Melbourne in 2020. They will need warm coats! If you are on Instagram, follow them at **teammelbs** 

They are in the thoughts and prayers of their families, their friends, and we hope, their parish also.
